Substantive knowledge: Christianity

EFYS	Children learn that people believe different things. Children look at a series of festivals and celebrations including Christmas and Easter
Year1	<u>Why do Christians give gifts at Christmas?</u> Learn about the Nativity and that Jesus was born at Christmas Learn that the Wise men visited Jesus and brought gifts Explore the Christian belief that Jesus is God's gift to the world Know that Christians give presents at Christmas

Year3	<u>What is Easter and why is it important to Christians?</u> Learn about the events of Palm Sunday Understand the significance of the last supper and how the Eucharist is still shared today in church Learn about the events in the Garden on Gethsemane leading up to Jesus being arrested including Peter's denial of knowing Jesus Learn about the crucifixion and the resurrection of Jesus Understand the meaning of the term 'Messiah'

Year5	<u>Stories of Christianity</u> Know that Christians believe that the Bible is the word of God Explore the story of Ruth and Naomi Explore the story of Daniel and understand how this relates to religious persecution that still happens today Know that Jesus told parables to illustrate moral or spiritual lessons Know that many Christians get baptised and that the first person to perform a baptism in the bible was John the Baptist Learn that Paul (Saul) started the early church through his writings and travels
