Year1	<u>Toys over time</u> Identify similarities and differences between toys from the past and present Explore how toys have improved over time Order toys from oldest to newest <u>Transport and travel</u> Understand how different forms of transport have change over time Compare modern transport to transport of the past Consider how travel has changed in the local area
Year2	<u>The Great Fire of London</u> Compare London in 1666 to London now Understand how London changed when it was rebuilt after the fire <u>Kings and Queens</u> Understand what a monarch is and identify some from different times of history saying how they were similar and different <u>People who made a difference</u> Consider how significant people bring about change
Year3	<u>Stone, Bronze and Iron Age</u> Use artefacts to identify changes that happened during the Stone Age Identify changes in the Bronze Age and the Iron Age and their impact compared to the Stone Age Find out how religious rituals changed Prehistoric Britain <u>Ancient Egypt</u> Understand that the power of the ruling Pharaoh continued throughout Ancient Egypt
Year4	<u>The Romans</u> Understand how Britain changed under the invasion of the Romans and later, the decline of the Roman Empire <u>Roman Britain</u> Understand the changes in settlements and infrastructure brought the Romans
Year5	<u>Vikings</u> Understand the changes brought about by the creation of the Danelaw <u>Baghdad and the Middle East</u> Identify how Baghdad became a centre of learning and the changes that brought to the Middle East
Year6	<u>Ancient Greeks</u> Understand how people rules in different ways in Ancient Greece <u>Conflict and resolution</u> Understand the changes to the role of Women in society brought about by WWI Understand what happened after the end of WWI Understand the impact of the Second World War on Britain Understand how Britain changes after WWII
