Year 1	<p>Collage with painted papers exploring colour, shape and composition.</p> <p>[SIMPLE PRINTMAKING]</p> <p>Combine collage with making by cutting and tearing drawn imagery, manipulating it into simple 3d forms to add to sculpture.</p> <p>[MAKING BIRDS]</p>	<p>Understand collage is the art of using elements of paper to make images.</p> <p>Understand we can create our own papers with which to collage.</p> <p>[MAKING BIRDS]</p>	<p>Paint</p> <p>Paper</p> <p>Card</p> <p>Glue</p> <p>Scissors</p>
Year 2	<p>Use the observational drawings made (see Drawing Progression), cutting the separate drawings out and using them to create a new artwork.</p> <p>Understand and think carefully about composition.</p> <p>Work into the collage with further drawing made in response to the collaged sheet.</p> <p>Collage with drawings to create invented forms.</p> <p>Combine with making if appropriate.</p> <p>[EXPLORE & DRAW]</p>	<p>Understand that we can combine collage with other disciplines such as drawing, printmaking and making.</p> <p>[EXPLORE & DRAW]</p>	<p>Drawing tools</p> <p>Scissors</p> <p>Glue</p> <p>Paper</p> <p>Card</p>
Year 3	<p>Cut shapes from paper (free hand) and use as elements with which to collage, combined with printmaking (see column 3 “printmaking”) to make a creative response to an original artwork.
