



## Homework Policy

### **This policy is intended to ensure:-**

- Homework is set consistently throughout the school with the weekly homework being set on a Friday to be completed and returned to school by the following Wednesday.
- All children are provided with a homework book in which homework can be recorded.
- Homework consolidates learning and prepares pupils for work to come
- Opportunities for parents, children and the school to work in partnership occur daily, weekly and termly
- Pupils begin to take responsibility for organising their own workload in preparation for the next stage of their education

### **Homework should enhance learning through:-**

- *Daily* reading – this might be reading alone or reading aloud to an adult \*

The expectations for daily reading are as follows:

EYFS and Years 1 and 2 - 10 minutes a day

Years 3 and 4 - 15 minutes a day

Years 5 and 6 - 20 minutes a day

- *Weekly* Maths homework which consolidates learning from the weeks maths lessons
- *Weekly* revision of spellings - taken from the Hurst Drive spelling scheme that is in line with the spelling appendix of the English programmes of study for key stages 1 and 2
